### Certified Logging Professional (CLP) Reinstatement Policy

**Purpose:**

To ensure that CLPs, regardless of certification category, continue to operate at the highest levels of professionalism expected of the designation, this policy has been established to address situations where loggers have requested recertification after their expiration date.

**Process of reinstatement:**

If a CLP is unable to recertify before their expiration date, the following time windows will determine their path to regaining certification.

Up to six (6) months after expiration: The logger can attend a recertification course, at the Board-approved recertification rate, to remain an active CLP without further requirements. The CLP database will reflect the period from January 1st until the recertification course was taken.

Six (6) months to five (5) years after expiration: The logger can attend a recertification course, at the Board-approved recertification rate. In addition, the logger must have an on-site evaluation at an active logging site conducted under CLP program guidelines and pay a \$100 reinstatement fee to cover the costs associated with the field inspection. Following a satisfactory report from the evaluation, the logger will regain certification dated to the first day of the year of the evaluation. The CLP database will reflect the period from January 1st of the year of lapsed certification until the recertification course was taken.

Greater than five (5) years after expiration: The logger must complete a new certification course, at the Board-approved certification rate. The CLP database will reflect the period from January 1st of the year of lapsed certification until a new certification course was taken.
